The 2's & 3's and 4's & 5's classes will do a study that introduces events written in the Gospels and the book of Acts in chronological order (*Part of Acts outline is not chronological). They are introduced these events in the 2's-3's class, then are reintroduced the exact same events in the 4's & 5's class, only with more detail. This is set up this way to give these age groups a good foundation on which to build upon as they enter the next phase of the curriculum in the 1st grade. The classes have crafts and activities suitable for each age group, and a lot of hands on learning. They also have memorization goals for Bible verses, and books of the Bible.

<p>How We Got the Bible</p> <p>Quarter 1</p> <p>This quarter involves a combined class effort in week 7 in which you will gather grades 1st-6th to do a group activity over ancient writing materials.</p>	<p>Students will study the inspiration of the Bible and learn how it was put together. They will be introduced to several vocabulary words as the quarter progresses to help build a good foundation for deeper study in future classes.</p>	<p>Students will study the inspiration of the Bible and how it was inspired by reintroducing concepts taught in the 1st & 2nd grade class, while adding new concepts.</p>	<p>Students will study the inspiration of the Bible, and archeological discoveries regarding the ancient texts. They will be reintroduced to vocabulary and concepts from the 3rd & 4th grade class, as well as introducing new ones.</p>
<p>The Gospels</p> <p>Quarter 2</p>	<p>Students will go over the timeline of Jesus' birth, life, ministry, death and resurrection, as well as learn facts pertaining to the prophecies and the way of life back in Biblical times.</p>	<p>Students will learn the need for Jesus' arrival, the story of his birth and his childhood, and will do character studies over the apostles. They will spend the rest of the quarter studying parables and truths Jesus taught during his ministry.</p>	<p>Students will compare prophecies about the Christ to the events in the Gospels as well as compare the Old Testament High Priest to Jesus, the Great High Priest. They will study major events during Jesus' ministry, as well as study in depth the events surrounding the betrayal, trial, death, and resurrection.</p>
<p>The Book of Acts</p> <p>Quarter 3</p> <p>In week 4, you will be studying the fellowship of the believers. You can use this class time to give a devotional over Acts chapter 2, then lead the classes in a service project involving things practiced in Acts 2.</p>	<p>Introduces students to the theme of the book of Acts, then goes over several of the major events that took place in Acts the rest of the quarter.</p>	<p>Reintroduces the theme and reasoning for the book of Acts, then goes on to study the events surrounding the establishment of the church. The students will do character studies over several people mentioned in the book of Acts, as well as trace the spread of the Gospel through Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria.</p>	<p>Reintroduces the theme and reasonings for the book of Acts, and focuses on the events covered in chapters 1-8, then focuses on the missionary journeys of Paul, and his trial. The students act as reporters recording the events that took place in Acts, and create a class newspaper with articles and illustrations.</p>

Galatians & Ephesians Quarter 4 This quarter has laced within it games that encourage unity within the classrooms, and within the church itself.	Students learn the purpose for the books of Galatians and Ephesians, then focus the rest of the quarter on the fruit of the Spirit and the armor of God. They study the words “faith” and “grace” as they relate to the books of Galatians and Ephesians.	Students are reintroduced to the purpose of the book of Galatians and Ephesians, while studying the fruits of the Spirit and the Armor of God. This is a review of things learned in 1st & 2nd, with new truths and concepts introduced for their age group.	Students are reintroduced to the purpose of the book of Galatians and Ephesians, and study to understand the reasonings for the letters. They study the terms “grace”, “faith”, and “spiritual warfare” as they relate to the books of Galatians and Ephesians. This quarter has extra time for life application study so teachers can discuss the issues this age group faces in their daily lives.

As you can see from the chart above, the students will all be covering the same subject matters, but they are built upon each year as the students mature. The first quarter is a topical study, and the 2nd & 3rd dig into textual studies over the Gospels and Acts. The 4th quarter wraps up year 1 with a focus on the letters of Galatians and Ephesians. Additional class materials will be available for purchase to be substituted for various age groups during quarters 1 and 4. For example, we will introduce “Me and My House”, a study over the family, involving children's classes in their respective age groups on Sunday mornings, as well as adult curriculum on Sunday's over the family. On Wednesday's, there will combined class time with children and parents.

All quarters will also have memory verses for memorization, as well as class goals for memorizing the books of the Bible and their authors, purpose, and time written.

The 2's & 3's and 4's & 5's classes will do a study that introduces events written in the Old Testament that will give them a grasp on all of the "major events" during this time in history. The majority of this study is chronological, but more of a study over several people of the Bible and their accounts. They are introduced these events in the 2's-3's class, then are reintroduced the exact same events in the 4's & 5's class, only with more detail. This is set up this way to give these age groups a good foundation on which to build upon as they enter the next phase of the curriculum in the 1st grade. The classes have crafts and activities suitable for each age group, and a lot of hands on learning. They also have memorization goals for Bible verses, and books of the Bible.

Quarter 4 The Proverbs- All classes Students will study the virtues found in the book of Proverbs with topics that relate to each individual age group. Students will study topics such as anger, jealousy, character, folly, integrity, generosity and so forth that are found in the book of Proverbs. These will be taught through life application, and character study over men and women in the Bible who struggled with, or excelled in these areas.	Students will study topics such as the mouth, wisdom, youth, vanity, courage, humility, and hypocrisy and so forth that are found in the book of Proverbs. Students will discuss life applications lessons, as well as do character studies over men and women in the Bible who struggled with, or excelled in these areas.

The first quarter of the Old Testament studies is a topical study over Creation, and the 2nd & 3rd quarters dig into a 6 month study of great texts and people of the Old Testament. The 4th quarter wraps up year 2 with a focus on the virtues found in the book of Proverbs. Additional class materials will be available for purchase to be substituted for various age groups during quarters 1 and 4. For example, we will introduce Godly Guys/Godly girls, a study for young ladies and young men on characteristics of godly men and women in the Bible. This class will be broken up into boy/girl classes with the age ranges being 1st-3rd and 4th-6th in each class. All quarters will also have memory verses for memorization, as well as class goals for memorizing the books of the Bible and their authors, purpose, and time written.
